TUFF TRUCK CHALLENGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The track will consist of different types of obstacles designed to test the limits of both vehicle and driver. Fastest time emerges victorious.

DRIVER ENTRY

1. Driver must be at least 16 yrs. of age. Under 18 must have a parental release form signed by parent or legal guardian..
2. All vehicles must be operated in a safe manner at all times.
3. All drivers and pit crewmembers must be clean and neatly attired at all times when appearing in public.
4. The appearance of your vehicle is up to you. Lettering, graphics, decals, etc. are optional but pictures; wording, etc. should not be offensive and will not be tolerated.
5. If any driver or their crew members are determined to be under the influence of an intoxicating agent of any kind, their vehicle will not compete for the duration of the event.

OPERATION OF EVENT

1. **Event Officials will govern contest with all decisions final.**
2. All drivers **MUST** attend drivers meeting prior to start of event.
3. Use of profanity and threats by any driver or crewmember to any official will subject crewmembers and vehicle to be removed from the grounds.
4. A driver may not start their run until they have been given a green flag to start their run or that run will be disqualified.
5. All vehicles will come to a complete stop at the end of their run and wait for a go signal from the finish line official.
6. A speed limit of 5 mph must be maintained in all non-competition areas.
7. Disposal of oil, fuel and excess parts must be done in an environmentally safe manner.
8. The event director has the right to stop and disqualify any vehicle not operated in a safe manner.
9. Should your safety harness become unfastened or drivers' door comes open during the event it will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
10. Vehicles must stay on the designated course. Altering the placement of a course marker will result in a 5 second time penalty for each marker knocked down. Event officials will determine if these markers were altered enough to warrant a penalty. Vehicles must completely cross each obstacle.

VEHICLE PREPARATION

1. Stock frame chassis only.
2. All vehicles must have fenders and hoods intact.
3. Floorboards shall be rigid and complete.
4. Multiple shock kits are allowed.
5. Shock mounting points may be redesigned, strengthened and/or modified.
6. No manually operated steering brakes.
7. All vehicles must have good working brakes.
8. After market exhaust allowed. May run open headers.
9. DOT helmet required. Wearing a neck collar is highly recommended.
10. It is preferred that all windows be removed, but it is not required.
11. Drivers and passenger door windows must be rolled down during the event.

SCORING

1. Each run will be timed and scored.
2. Each vehicle will make two (2) runs as the event progresses..
3. The driver with the lowest time of the two runs will be declared the overall winner.

ENTRY FEE

Driver must pay general gate admission and pay entry fee. All other persons must pay general gate admission plus purchase a pit pass in order to enter the pit area.
